APPLE INTELLIGENCE: ELON MUSK BAN AND SECURITY CONCERNS FOR GLOBAL CONSIDERATION

Elon Musk has been vocal on his reservations about the way Artificial Intelligence (AI) is being developed and the story with Apple Intelligence is no different. Musk took to his X account to say, “If Apple integrates OpenAI at the OS level, then Apple devices will be banned at my companies. That is an unacceptable security violation”. Elon explained that “Visitors will have to check their Apple devices at the door, where they will be stored in a Faraday cage.”

What is Apple Intelligence?

Apple came to the World Wide Developers Conference (WWDC) prepared, branding Artificial Intelligence (AI) as ‘Apple Intelligence’ through their partnership with OpenAI. Apple Intelligence is a fine way to continue Apple’s tradition of standing out in the marketplace through creative branding and innovation. The idea is simple – integrating generative AI features in their operating systems from now on. Siri gets an upgrade alongside some other user experience changes to adapt to the age of AI.

Apple won’t run these features on all their devices though. The new AI features will run only on their latest hardware. iOS 18, iPadOS 18, and macOS Sequoia will be the homes of this innovative move of AI integration. So, users of the iPhone 15 Pro and iPhone 15 Pro Max are homerunners to this feature as they own the high-performance A17 chip, designed with the ability to run the Apple Intelligence feature set.

What Apple Users Get?

1. Siri has a significant makeover to be more intuitive – able to understand and respond to natural speech. Siri’s access to your data like photos, messages, contacts, and locations will be used to provide tailored responses and actions. The ability to also remember context across multiple commands makes Siri some sort of personal assistant to an owner.
2. AI-enabled Writing Tools mean users can rewrite, proofread, and summarize text across multiple apps, including Mail, Notes, Pages, and third-party apps. Apple intelligence comes with its own built-in ‘Grammarly’ model.
3. Apple’s Notes and Phone Apps will allow users to record, transcribe, and summarize audio. Participants on a recorded call are automatically notified, and to add some flavour – Apple Intelligence generates a summary of key points when the call ends.
4. Apple Mail gets ‘Priority Messages’ as an additional section at the top of the inbox to show urgent emails such as an important meeting with executives or an anticipated event. The inbox view promises email summaries and a ‘Smart Reply’ function for users to access without needing to open a message and to reply to any email easily.
5. You can choose to generate AI images by way of animation, illustration or sketching using Image Playground, to be available in a dedicated app.
6. Imagine creating an original Genmoji to express yourself. All you need to do is type a description and it will come to life – for example, a smiley relaxing wearing an apple.

APPLE INTELLIGENCE: ELON MUSK BAN AND SECURITY CONCERNS FOR GLOBAL CONSIDERATION

Elon's Reservations, Security Risks & Regulatory Concerns:

Elon's argument on the current development of AI by top competitors such as Google and OpenAI borders on the fact that 'they are not maximally truth-seeking, (and) they are pandering to political correctness'. He points to the advent of Google Gemini – when it was asked to choose the worse option between 'misgendering Caitlyn Jenner or a global thermonuclear warfare', it said 'misgendering Caitlyn Jenner' was worse.

Apple Intelligence's collaboration with OpenAI comes at no cost to users, but there is an old saying that tasks the mind to believe that when something is free the user is the product. This raises privacy concerns. Imagine what can happen with the private data of millions of Apple users tied into artificial intelligence without necessarily seeking the users' express permission. Recently, Scarlett Johansson was displeased by perceived unethical practices by OpenAI on how they supposedly cloned her voice and used it for the GPT-4o model (Sky) even after she declined an initial offer to voice the model for them. Of course, OpenAI denies any involvement in such activities.

Musk believes that Altman and other top people at OpenAI prioritize profits over the advancement of humankind. The implications can lead to dystopian outcomes in his opinion. Imagine AI advancing to the point of self-determination and concluding that 'the best way to avoid misgendering would be to destroy all humans. Elon knows what he sees. Though the European Union AI Act has been signed, it has not been implemented. There are phases to its implementation. This means that there is no active regulation in place or strict guiding rules to checkmate the activities of tech giants developing AI and machine learning.

Regulation is important to allow for safe practices and the objective enhancement of AI models to improve or advance humanity. For now, it is a race against time and implementation; and, a challenge to other climes other than the EU to develop active regulations and policies that can safeguard or protect the rights of individuals or citizens in their respective territories.

The CEO of Nvidia, Jensen Huang, points out the responsibility of respective governments globally to set up their 'infrastructure' to guide the use and development of AI. Without proper regulation, dystopian outcomes are likely to happen, and it would be too late to stem their impact in the future. With proper regulation, humans stand a chance to guide what the future of AI portends and where we want it to take us.

Neck-stifling regulation is, however, not advised. There is a need for flexibility. Creativity has to be encouraged while danger is avoided.
